What is the Workshop about?

The purpose of this workshop is to teach and demonstrate the use of game analysis and video systems as a coaching tool for players and coaches. GACU & Harbour Sport have established a Coaches Resource Room, complete with Game Breaker, Silicon Coach and other resources. Participants will be shown how to use these resources and integrate within their current coaching practices.

The presenter will discuss how the appropriate use of technology can improve the learning and understanding of player performances, decision making and raising awareness. The presenter will also explain video analysis in a simple and easy to use manner and also share information about the latest technological trends.

About the Presenters – Jamie Ryan, Sportstec

Jamie Ryan is the National Support Manager for Sportstec in Australia and has been an Elite level Sportscode user since 1999. He started off as a Water Polo scholarship coach at the Australia Institute of Sport where he was responsible for scouting & team analysis with the National Men's Water Polo 2000 Olympic campaign. From 2001 through 2004, Jamie was an Assistant coach and Performance analyst for the Australian National Women's Water Polo Team. During this stint, the team competed in the 2003 World Championships & 2004 Athens Olympic Games. During this same period, he was also the Head Women's Water Polo Coach for the NSW Institute of Sport.

From 2005 to mid 2008, he was the Performance Analysis Coordinator and Senior Sport Scientist for the NSW Institute of Sport. His responsibilities included the delivery and implementation of Sportscode and other analysis tools to over 30 different sports programs at the Institute. Whilst 50% of the sports at the institute are individual ones, his primary focus was in team sports analysis and the ongoing training and competition support for the staff and coaches.
