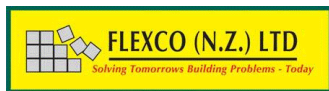

PAPAKURA NETBALL CENTRE

- ◆ Papakura Netball Centre has been in existence since 1938, back then it was known as Papakura Basketball Club and began playing at the Papakura Croquet club grounds. After a number of moves, the Papakura Netball Centre moved to Bruce Pulman Park in 1997. The Centre now has a large pavilion that caters for all its needs and 26 courts.
- ◆ The netball season runs from March to August and the Centre has 37 netball clubs, with 205 teams in 2010. It offers grades including Premier, Senior, Collegiate, Intermediate, Junior and Future Ferns.
- ◆ Papakura offers a representative programme for its players and caters for U19, U17, U15, Y9, Y8 and Y7 teams.
- ◆ A highlight for the Centre is to see the courts full and everyone enjoying themselves playing and watching netball from babies in prams to proud grandparents on the side-line.
